This individual will communicate directly with royalty owners, mineral owners, and working interest owners with the handling of transfers, inquiries, and address changes.

- Analyze leases, contracts, title opinions, and development history prior to creating DOI and JIB decks for producing units to ensure proper and accurate decks are created timely
