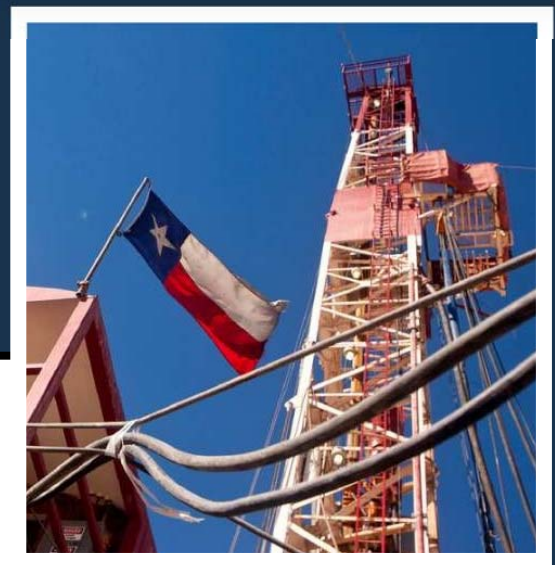

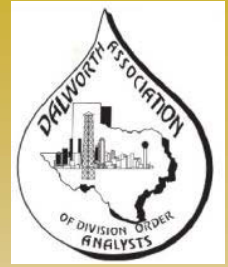

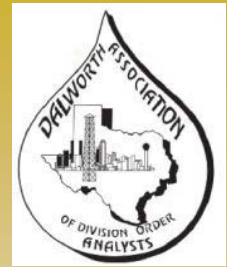
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President's Corner:

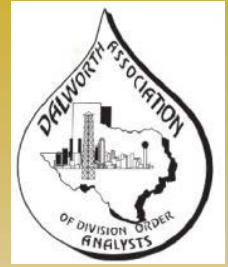
It has been a great pleasure to serve as President of DALWORTH for the last two years.

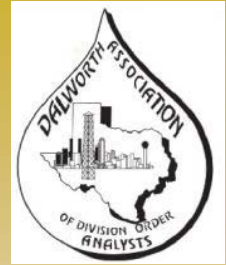


2016 DALWORTH CHRISTMAS PARTY

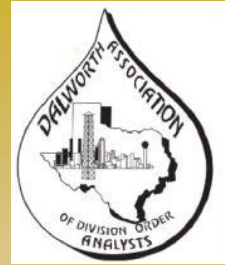
January 2017 Introductory Luncheon

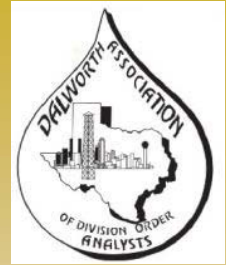

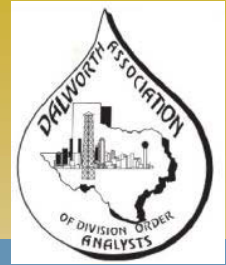

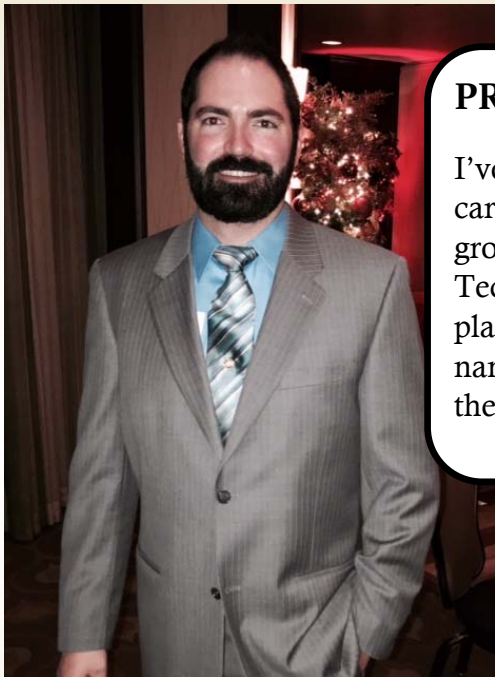

PRESIDENT—LEWIS BOX

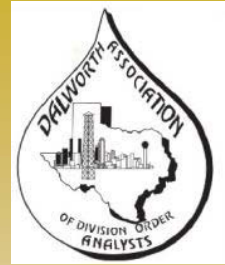

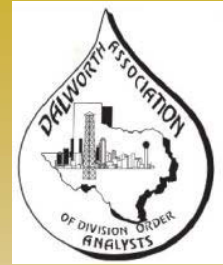

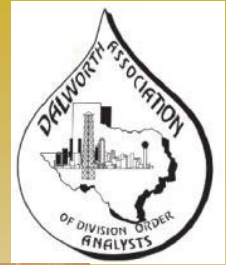
DIRECTOR - HOSPITALITY—ELI MURRAY

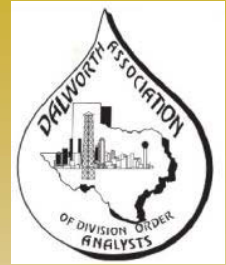
