### Award Criteria:

Awards will be based on **overall academic achievement, essay originality as well as proper spelling and grammar, letters of recommendation and student's character.**

Applications will be judged by the Scholarship Committee.

All Scholarship applicants will be notified by mail once a final decision has been reached. Scholarships will be awarded at the Dalworth luncheon scheduled for July 17, 2018. ***Applicant, or representative, and member are required to be present.***

#### President — MELANIE FINNEGAN

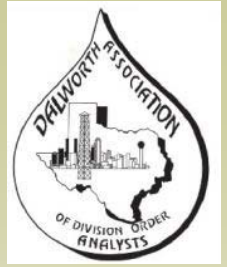

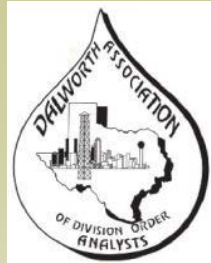
2ND Vice President —JENNIFER DODGEN

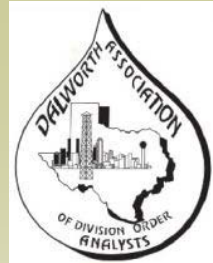

Treasurer—ANGELA KORTHAUER

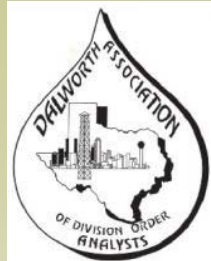

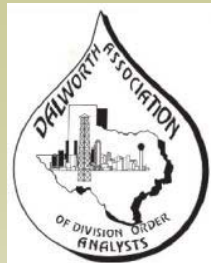
## Total U.S. Rig Count
