## SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION 2016

The Dalworth Association of Division Order Analysts is proud to offer scholarships for any graduating senior, or individual returning to school, of the Members and their immediate families. These scholarships are intended to reward good students of their accomplishments and to encourage their future academic pursuits.

Requirements for consideration:

### Applicant must:

- be a member or part of the member's family
- be at least a graduating high school senior
- must have a grade point average of 3.0 or greater
- intend to use the award for the current or immediately following school year
- earn a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester (full-time student)
- provide the name of the accredited college, university or community college the student will attend

### Criteria for consideration:

- Two (2) letters of recommendation
- Copy of current High School/College (University) transcript
- Submit a 1 to 2 page essay –choice of subjects.

*How has the downturn in oil and gas prices affected major producing states such as Texas, Oklahoma, North Dakota etc.*

*Select a topic/event/job in the oil and gas industry and discuss the changes that have occurred in the past, how it is in the present and what may be happening/changing in the future.*

*How do foreign oil sales affect you and me?*

*How does the Texas Railroad Commission regulate the oil and gas industry?*

*How is the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolis impacted by the oil and gas industry.*

### Award Criteria:

- Awards will be based on **overall academic achievement, essay originality as well as proper spelling and grammar, letters of recommendation and student's character.**
- Applications will be judged by the Scholarship Committee.
- All Scholarship applicants will be notified by mail once a final decision has been reached. Scholarship(s) will be awarded at a meeting determined by the Dalworth Board. ***Applicant or representative and member are required to be present.***
- Scholarships awarded will be paid directly to the winning applicant. Payment shall be authorized once the Committee receives satisfactory proof of enrollment at a fully accredited institution.
- All decisions made by the Dalworth Association of Division Order Analysts are final.
